

SERMON TEXT - LUKE 11:1-4

1 Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." 2 And he said to them, "When you pray, say:

"Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. 3 Give us each day our daily bread, 4 and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation."

The Lord's Prayer - Part 2

Luke 11:1-4

Theme: *Prayer teaches us about the heart of God.*

#1. Give Us Each Day Our Daily Bread

- A. Learning About God: *We rely on Him for everything.*
- B. Learning About Prayer: *Our greatest daily need is Jesus Himself.*

#2 - Forgive Us Our Sins

- A. Learning About God: *He is patient and slow to anger.*
- B. Learning About Prayer: *We are called to honest self reflection.*

#3 - For We Ourselves Forgive Everyone Who is Indebted To Us

- A. Learning About God: *His forgiveness is full and final.*
- B. Learning About Prayer: *Forgiving others is a work that God does in us.*

#4 - And Lead Us Not Into Temptation.

- A. Learning About God: *He does not tempt us, but enticed by our desires.*
- B. Learning About Prayer: *God wants our heart to conform to His.*

New City Catechism - What is sin?
