SERMON TEXT - PSALM 19

To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David

- 1 The heavens declare the glory of God,
and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.
- 2 Day to day pours out speech,

whose voice is not heard.
- 4 Their voice goes out through all the earth,
